NEW POWER CONNECTION REGULATIONS

Please note that Westpark will be implementing new regulations regarding connections of vessels and appliances to shore power.

The regulations will take effect on **1 February 2011**.

1. Connecting your vessel to the marina's 16 amp power supply;

- Your vessel must have current Warrant of Electrical Fitness ("EWOFF").
- You must have a minimum of third party insurance cover.
- Your power lead must be tested annually, and display a current compliance tag.

2. Connecting your vessel to the marina's 10 amp power supply;

- Your vessel must have current Warrant of Electrical Fitness ("EWOFF").
- You must have a minimum of third party insurance cover.
- You must have a certified lead with the appropriate locking plug
- Your power lead must be tested annually, and display a current compliance tag.

3. Connecting an appliance to the marina's power supply.

- The lead connecting the appliance and shore power must be the appropriate heavy duty lead with a suitable protective lock ring on the plug. Your power lead must be tested annually, and display a current compliance tag.
- Under no circumstances, will a "domestic" lead be able to be used.
- A maximum of 3 days unattended power will be permitted.
